



Delaware Respite Care Options:

Aging Individuals and Grandparents

Who?

Individuals over the age of 60 or grandparents caring for a dependent child.

What is available?

The following programs are funded by a variety of sources. Contact the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) or specific organization for more information.

Adult Day Services

Eligibility: Individuals age 60+ with functional impairment

Cost/Limitations: No cost for Medicaid recipients. Limited slots by program

Respite Care: Aging

Eligibility: Individuals under age 60+

Cost/Limitations: No cost. \$500 per year per person

Delaware Lifespan Respite Care Network

Eligibility: Children or adults with disabilities and/or special healthcare needs

Cost/Limitations: No cost. \$500 per year per person, funds are limited

Respite Care: Grandparents

Eligibility: Delaware residents aged 50 or over who are providing the majority of care to children aged 17 or younger and who are related to them by blood, marriage, or adoption

Cost/Limitations: No cost.
